



CHANGES TO CIC IMMIGRATION MEDICAL EXAMINATION FEES IN BAGUIO

Please note that effective Sept. 15, 2015 the CIC Immigration Medical Examination Fee in Baguio will change to include the following:

- The initial Immigration Medical Examination (IME) and all required initial testing plus
- Any subsequent necessary investigations and treatment for tuberculosis (TB) through the CIC Panel Physician site in Baguio.

You will note that there will be an increase in the current IME fee across all age groups, but this means that applicants will not have to pay any additional fees for any required TB investigations or TB treatment during the IME process if it is done through the panel physician site where they did the initial IME.

Please note that applicants will still have to pay additional fees for any other additional tests/referrals needed for non-TB related issues.

This new one all-inclusive IME fee is being rolled out in Manila on Sept. 1, 2015 and will then be rolled out to the rest of the CIC Panel Physician sites in the Philippines over the next 1 – 2 months.
