

REMINDERS:

- A. Before coming for your medical examination, you must lodge your visa application, either with the Australian Embassy or via eVisa systems
- B. Applicants are advised to take their meals prior to coming over for their medical examination since food is not allowed within the premises and all the initial blood and urine tests do not require fasting.
- C. FOR PREGNANT Applicants please bring OB_Gyne consent prior to xray.
- D. Females within the reproductive age group are advised not to schedule their medical examination during their menstrual period. Otherwise, they will be required to come back one week after the last day of their menstruation.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- A. Referral Letter from Australian Embassy which contains your HAP ID/ TRN number
- B. Completely filled out downloaded forms (Please download and fill out forms to facilitate processing)

C. Valid Original Passport

* If original passport is not available:

- a Health Examinations List (HAP letter) (or equivalent documentation from the Department that shows which health examinations are required) and a copy of your passport photo page that has been certified by the department or an AVAC.
- a Health Examinations List (HAP letter) with a photograph attached together with stamp/seal from the Department.
- For **Non migrating dependent PERMANENT applicants** who does not have a passport or already submitted to Australian Embassy, You may present two (2) Government issued IDs such as:
 - a. BIR ID (Laminated with photo)
 - b. Voter's ID (Laminated with photo)
 - c. SSS ID
 - d. Postal ID
 - e. PRC ID
 - f. Unified Multi- purpose ID

- For children (non-migrating)- NSO Birth Certificate and at least one form of identification with photo
(Birth certificates issued by the Local Civil Registrar (LCR) in lieu of NSO Birth Certificates, are not acceptable. For an applicant born in a country other than the Philippines, please bring the birth certificate issued by the government in the country of birth.)

D. Please bring all medical records if available

- For applicants with history of Pulmonary TB treatment- Old Chest Xray films not less than 6 months prior to medical examination
- Medical certificate regarding a previously treated or currently managed clinically significant illness which should contain the following information:
 - Duration and date of treatment
 - surgical procedure or medical intervention done
 - complete final diagnosis
 - outcome of treatment or treatment plans and prognosis

Medical Examinations Requirements

A. PERMANENT VISA APPLICANTS	
Age	Required Examinations
0 - 1 years old	Medical History and Physical Examination
2 - 4 years old	Medical History and Physical Examination, Tuberculin Skin Test(TST)/ IGRA
5 - 10 years old	Medical History and Physical Examination, urinalysis, Tuberculin Skin Test(TST)/ IGRA
11 - 14 years old	Medical History and Physical Examination, urinalysis, chest x-ray (CXR)
15 years old and above	Medical History and Physical Examination, urinalysis, CXR, HIV
<p>Permanent visa applicants 2-10 years old are required to undertake either a Tuberculin Skin Test (TST) OR a TB Blood Test (Interferon Gamma Release Assay or IGRA)</p> <p>♣ Tuberculin Skin Test (TST) requires 2 clinic visits. Second visit is between 48 and 72 hours from TST placement.</p> <p>To avoid TST from becoming invalidated, please be at the clinic at least an hour before the schedule written on your TST return slip.</p> <p>♣ The TB Blood Test (Interferon Gamma Release Assay or IGRA) will only require 1 clinic visit if results are negative.</p> <p>Chest X-ray will be required for children 10 years old and below if they have a positive TST/IGRA result or have exposure to TB Cases or a history of TB disease</p>

Age	Required Examinations
0 - 4 years old	Medical History and Physical Examination
5 - 10 years old	Medical History and Physical Examination, urinalysis
11 - 14 years old	Medical History and Physical Examination, urinalysis, chest x-ray (CXR)
15 years old and above	Medical History and Physical Examination, urinalysis, CXR,
Chest X-ray will also be required for children 10 years old and below if they have had exposure to TB Cases or history of TB disease.	
C. STUDENT OR WORKER (HOSPITAL OR HEALTHCARE)	
Medical History and Physical Examination, Chest X-ray, HIV, HBsAg, and Anti-HCV (regardless of length of stay)
