

## REMINDERS:

1. Applicants are advised to take their meals prior to coming over for their medical examination since food is not allowed within the premises and all the initial blood and urine tests do not require fasting.
2. Females within the reproductive age group are advised not to schedule their medical examination during their menstrual period. Otherwise, they will be required to come back one week after the last day of their menstruation.
3. FOR PREGNANT Applicants please bring OB\_Gyne consent prior to xray

## REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

**A.** Completely filled out downloaded forms ( Please download and fill out forms to facilitate processing )

**B.** Valid original passport

For passports that are currently being held by the embassy, the applicant may present an email from New Zealand Embassy providing a scanned copy of their passport and any ONE (1) Government issued ID such as:

- BIR ID (laminated with photo)
- Voter's ID (laminated with photo)
- SSS ID
- Postal ID
- PRC ID
- Unified Multi Purpose ID
- Driver's license

For children- NSO Birth Certificate and at least one form of identification with photo (e.g. school ID) (Birth certificates issued by the Local Civil Registrar (LCR) in lieu of NSO Birth Certificates are **NOT** acceptable.)

**C.** Please bring all medical records if available

- For applicants with history of Pulmonary TB treatment- Old Chest Xray films not less than 6 months prior to medical examination
- Medical certificate regarding a previously treated or currently managed clinically significant illness which should contain the following information:
  - Duration and date of treatment
  - surgical procedure or medical intervention done
  - complete final diagnosis
  - outcome of treatment or treatment plans and prognosis

## Medical Examination Requirements

Age	Required Examinations
0 - 4 years old	Physical Examination
5 - 10 years old	Physical Examination, urinalysis
11 - 14 years old	Physical Examination, urinalysis, chest x-ray (CXR)
15 years old and above	Physical Examination, Urinalysis, CXR, HIV, Syphilis, CBC, Hepatitis B Antigen, Hepa-C, Hbaic, Creatinine
